

IMMERSIVE TRIP FAQ

If you have any additional questions, please do not hesitate to ask.

What's the price breakdown?

The cost of the Immersive Trip is \$950 and covers all transportation, MAVEN costs, activities, lodging, the cost of adult leaders, a trip journal, and all things necessary for a safe and fun week. We were able to keep the price below the actual cost due to Grace Fellowship Church underwriting. Below you will find a per person price breakdown of where your money will go.

Per Person Price Breakdown:

MAVEN Student Cost = \$660
Transportation = \$66
Training Costs = \$133
Food = \$300
Housing = \$316
Misc Costs = \$104

Actual Total Cost = \$1579

Grace Fellowship Underwriting = (\$629)

OVERFLOW Cost = \$950

Registration requires a \$150 deposit followed by either a full payment or payment plan. We understand this cost is significant especially for families with multiple children but as usual we do not want finances to be the reason your child cannot attend camp. Can my family fundraise for this trip?

Although this is not explicitly a "mission trip", we will be partnering with Christian missionaries and churches in Utah to support them and we will of course be praying for opportunities to share the gospel and minister to the LDS community. Fundraising is a great way to not only alleviate the cost of the trip but to also bring a team of people together to be a part of what God is doing! If you are in need of financial assistance we are asking that you ask at least 1-3 people to join you by giving financially to your trip before we allocate any assistance. We will explain this process at our first training and will be alongside you throughout the entire fundraising process.

What are the transportation arrangements?

We will be taking two Grace Fellowship Church vans, driven by Trevor Lawrence and Jessica Murrietta. Drop off and pick up will be at Grace Fellowship Church. (Dramamine is recommended for kids who are prone to car sickness.)

What are the sleeping arrangements?

All students will be sleeping in separate rooms by gender at a church that MAVEN has asked to host. There will be 1 leader in both of the rooms. The first and last two nights of the trip we will be staying in an Airbnb style rental and students will be assigned rooms based on gender.

What is the student to leader ratio and who are the leaders?

Our typical ratio for this trip is 6 students to one leader.

What does my student do with their medication?

Grace Fellowship Church requires all medication, including Advil and supplements/vitamins, to be checked-in. Please have all medication in the original prescription or over-the-counter bottle and labeled at check-in to turn in to OVERFLOW Staff. Jessica will administer all medications at their designated time to be taken to students, this will be done privately to respect students medical privacy.

Is my child allowed to bring their cell phone? Am I allowed to contact my child throughout the weekend?

We do not allow students to bring any electronics for any reason. When you check your child in on the day of departure, we will give you a list of emergency numbers. If there is an emergency or you need to get ahold of your child, you have permission to call our OVERFLOW staff and we will connect you with your child. A week away from cell phones is a great way to rest from electronics.

My child is nervous about being away from home, how can I encourage them prior to the trip?"

It is completely normal for students to feel anxious about being away from home. We recommend the following when talking to your child...

1. Encourage them that they are not the only ones feeling this way.
2. Remind them that there are leaders available for them for anything that they need.
3. This is an awesome time for them to grow and meet new people.
