What is the purpose of this trip?

The purpose of this trip is to engage with Grace's initiative to get to know and serve our local community by partnering with local nonprofits Grace supports. With each organization, we will have the privilege to hear from leaders about their mission, engage in interviews to further our understanding of how God is working in our community, and serve with them in their particular work.

Where will we be staying?

We will be staying at Grace! Boys will be in the Junior High Room and the girls in the High School Room. We will have couches and air mattresses to sleep on. Only pillows and sleeping bags will be needed.

What does the trip cost cover?

The trip cost covers all meals, transportation, and trip merchandise (which makes up a very small portion of the overall cost).

What safety precautions do you take?

We will be encouraging students to be mindful of preventative measures like drinking lots of water, eating each meal, communicating any symptoms with a leader and being careful when engaging in physical activities. In the event that we need to take a student to the hospital, Grace Fellowship will have a leader (or two) who will be our designated hospital runner for the trip. We will always communicate with parents ASAP in case of an emergency.
